5. Meeting open to the public for discussion of agenda items.

- Mrs. Garcia stated that the Board is violating the Bylaws because the meeting is out of order with the way that the Agenda is set-up.
- Mr. Lebreault stated the Bylaws provide a suggestion as to how the Agenda should be set-up.
- Mr. Stern stated that the Board has the power to set the Agenda and to do what needs to be done in order to conduct its business.
- Public member #1 - asked about Curriculum item #11 and the revised Vice Principal job description.
- Dr. Rodriguez stated that Curriculum item #11 deals with a person who has been accepted by the district to do a research study at the high school during the upcoming school year. They will be working with Dr. Collazo on an program evaluation of the Read 180 Program. With regards to the Vice Principal position, the job description has been changed to encompass the duties of the Visual and Performing Arts Academy so that there is only one person working with both areas. The successful person for this position will also help the district with the curriculum for visual and performing arts for grades K-12.
- Public member #2 - asked about Curriculum item #39 of the agenda and wanted to know if the band and ensemble would be invited to the gala on the Cornucopia as well or are they just going to perform.
- Mr. Lebreault stated that the band and ensemble will be invited to attend the gala after they perform.
- Public member #3 – was glad to see that Buildings and Grounds item #3 is on the agenda. This will help the district to be successful and build strong relationships with the community. This is a positive step forward, however since the school is on Smith Street, perhaps we could think of another location as it will be hard for people to park there. We need to use our resources to reach as many parents as possible. Dr. Rodriguez stated that a committee was formed to work on this idea and they are responsible for putting this event together. There will be a lot of volunteers who will work with the parents and do the presentations. We don't have all the information at this time, but Dr. Rodriguez stated that she will review the information and get back to you.
- Public member #4 - asked about Athletics and Co-curricular item #1. He stated that he believes that these stipends will be approved tonight unanimously however there have been no public discussions on the need for a bilingual coach for any of these positions. Were these jobs posted publicly? Is it the case that only Perth Amboy employees were considered? Did any outside candidate interview? Do all the coaches listed on tonight's agenda meet the requirements set forth by the State for qualification of coaches? Are the coaches in possession of NJ teaching certificates? Have all current coaches met the necessary certification in training? Is Mr. Cardona in possession of certificates verifying that all his newly hired coaches, including volunteers, have completed the NFHS Fundamentals of coaching course? Coaches have 120 days from the date of hire to complete the course and the certificate must

- Public member #4(continued) - be on file with the AD or Supervisor by June 30<sup>th</sup> in order for a coach to be eligible to coach at an NJSIAA School for the subsequent school year. Lastly did all newly hired coaches, including coaches for the winter and spring of 2013-2014, complete first aid, CPR and concussion awareness training as mandated by NJSIAA? Is there a plan in place to ensure that the Athletic Department is in full compliance? I'd like these questions answered because there were a lot of questions regarding other positions in the past but it appears that was only a one-time thing and now no one is questioning any of these positions.
- Dr. Rodriguez stated that Mr. Cardoña is not here to answer these questions so she would like to have more information on these items before moving forward with their approval. Dr. Rodriguez stated that she was going to table this item until she gets more information. Mr. Stern stated that all personnel matters must be recommended by the Superintendent of Schools, however the Superintendent just stated that hearing that based upon public questions she will administratively withdrawal this item.

In year 1 implementation required many decisions to be made with regards to securing a vendor, professional development for administrators and staff, SGO training and submission to the state, etc. In year 2 I would like to develop a district-wide vision for evaluation that will encourage educators to see the inherent value of the NJ Achieve evaluation support system. "If you do the things Achieve NJ asks you to, you're actually applying best practices." The District Evaluation Advisory Committee (DEAC) is required by Achieve NJ through at least school year 2016-2017. This committee has great potential for supporting districts in effectively implementing Achieve NJ. The Superintendent of Schools is responsible for the formation of this committee. The Superintendent must decide how to use this committee and should clearly communicate the DEAC role is providing feedback. The DEAC will be the vehicle that will create a true supportive system. With the new recommended position of Director of Personnel and Evaluation the Superintendent will have a district – level Director to help run this committee, provide guidance to principals with evaluations and coaching, help address district-wide implementation concerns, monitor and evaluate along with the principals, the district instructional leaders, use Teachscape to conduct evaluations, contribute to making rehire decisions with annual summary evaluation, debrief observers experiences after co-observations with principals and suggest activities to promote inter rater reliability based on the job evaluation experience. In addition to the new duties and responsibilities of the Director of Personnel and Evaluation, the duties and responsibilities of this position will include the ones the HR Manager conducts presently.
- Mr. Ortiz asked if the DEAC Committee requires a Director of Human Resources to be a participant on the committee. This was a misrepresentation because the committee must include a parent, a member of the Board of Education, the Superintendent, one or more administrators, the Director of Special Services, a teacher from each grade level and one or more central administrators who oversee evaluations.
- Dr. Rodriguez said the DEAC is in place and all the people you mentioned are on it; including the Director of Personnel and Evaluation, the Human Resources Manager was included before the title was changed. The DEAC will be the vehicle to make the new evaluation system work better this year. The candidate has the necessary experience; she's worked with Teachscape; was a Principal and worked in the field and with teachers. We'll move forward and be better with all good information. Dr. Rodriguez did not say that this person will run the DEAC or be on it, but she will help to run it and it will work better.
- Mr. Ortiz asked how many times did you interview Ms. Sheard and Dr. Rodriguez said two.
- Mr. Ortiz asked when was the first time that she was interviewed.

14. **Recommendations of the Acting Superintendent of Schools**

D. **Personnel Committee – Mr. Samuel Lebreault, Chairperson**

- Dr. Rodriguez said she doesn't remember the date. She was on vacation for two weeks and when she returned, she looked at all the candidates and feels that this was the best person and this person could start August 1<sup>st</sup>. She's committed to making it work for our district. The new evaluation process is a statewide initiative.
- Mr. Ortiz asked Dr. Rodriguez when she returned from vacation and Dr. Rodriguez replied July 15<sup>th</sup>.
- Mr. Ortiz asked who interviewed the candidate first. Dr. Rodriguez said she did and someone from HR. Mr. Jess was on vacation, Mr. Grobelny had jury duty and Mr. Rotella had retired.
- Mr. Ortiz asked how could you interview her on the 17<sup>th</sup> when her application was submitted in Applitrack on the 18<sup>th</sup>. The interview could have been done after the job was no longer posted. You interviewed her before she applied for the job and that could be illegal.
- Dr. Rodriguez stated that in June the Board provided her with the permission to hire employees over the summer. This is a very important person and we took the necessary steps to ensure that the position was filled.
- Mr. Ortiz made a motion to table this item, Personnel item #30.
- Mr. Stern said to the Board that Mr. Ortiz made a motion to table this item. He motion is a privileged motion, so it must be dealt with immediately. The Board can ask any questions they feel are necessary and they should be respectful, however when there's a second there's no more discussion and the Board must vote.
- Mrs. Garcia seconded the motion to table Personnel item #30.
- Roll Call vote to table Personnel item #30:  
Yes – Roman, Ortiz, Garcia  
No – Gonzalez, Varela, Puccio, Lebreault, Bermudez, Tejeda  
The motion to table Personnel item #30 does not pass 3-6.
- Mr. Ortiz said that's a way to squash the vote.
- Mr. Stern said the Board President has the authority to close the discussion and can also decide when the vote will be taken.
- Mr. Ortiz respectfully disagreed.
- Mr. Stern stated that the Board President stated that the time for debate is over.
- Mr. Ortiz said if we vote on something that's against the law, you can't do it. The Board President is not following the procedure. Mr. Ortiz will bring action against the Board because you are not following Robert's Rules. The person who makes the initial motion gets to debate first.
- Mr. Stern stated to Mr. Ortiz that he made a motion to table an item and the motion failed. The individual making the motion does not have the right to determine the length of debate and the Board President can close the debate at any time.
- Mrs. Garcia stated that because this is a very important position we need to debate it. This shouldn't create confrontation by asking questions. This item was placed on the Agenda at the last minute and sufficient information was not provided to the Board members.
- Mr. Ortiz said the Personnel Committee always does this and it's disturbing, but they don't want us to do our research. To squash debate on such an important issue regarding someone who is going to see all the potential employee evaluations is disconcerting.
- Mr. Stern stated that the Board is not bound by every single letter of Robert's Rules. It's relevant to those body's that don't meet very often and in their interest to make sure those meetings runs effectively. This body needs to show the public that it is running efficiently. Robert's Rules is not used to filibuster or use items that have no relevance to a meeting. We are bound by N.J.S.A. 18A.
- Mr. Ortiz reminded the Board that the bylaws say to follow Robert's Rules and Order, but this Board has a bad habit of not following the bylaws. Mr. Ortiz doesn't know who was on the interview committee or how many times she was interviewed.
- Mr. Stern read from N.J.S.A. 18A - 'the Board shall appoint, transfer or remove staff only upon the recommendation of the Chief School Administrator and recorded majority roll call vote'.
- Mr. Ortiz stated that this person applied for the job on the same day the posting ended. How is it she was interviewed before she applied for the position? The potential candidate doesn't have HR experience.
- Mr. Stern said he will not debate legal matters in public and Mr. Ortiz's comments have been duly noted.
- Mr. Stern said the major interest is the public, to serve them and do all the work in public with few exceptions. The Board adjourned into executive session to discuss several areas regarding personnel. According to NJSA 18A 10:4-12, 'a public body may exclude the public from any matter involving employment, applications, terminations, terms and conditions of employment and discipline'.

14. **Recommendations of the Acting Superintendent of Schools**

D. **Personnel Committee – Mr. Samuel Lebreault, Chairperson**

- This means that anyone who applies for a job in Perth Amboy can count on the fact that questions about their qualifications will be asked in private. The Board can, and is encouraged to, ask questions in closed session so as not to debate qualifications in public. So far all the questions have been process questions, but you must be careful about discussing qualification related questions/items in public but you can discuss these issues in closed session if need be.
- Mr. Ortiz stated that while he appreciates the advice and will follow it, the debate regarding the potential interview of a candidate before she applied for the position and the fact that this information was just given to us yesterday raises questions. He saw the candidate with the Personnel Committee and it's against the code of ethics for a Board member to participate in interviews, but you'd think that a Board member with ethics charges against them would abstain.
- Mrs. Garcia stated that the Board should go into executive session to ask questions about this recommendation.
- A motion was made by Ms. Garcia and seconded by Mr. Ortiz to go into executive session for the purpose of discussion about Personnel Item #30. Roll call vote:
  - Yes – Ortiz, Garcia
  - No – Gonzalez, Varela, Puccio, Lebreault, Bermudez, Tejeda, Roman
  - This motion does not pass - 2-7.
- A motion was then made by Mr. Bermudez to close the debate on Personnel item #30, seconded by Mr. Lebreault. Roll call vote:
  - No – Roman, Ortiz, Garcia
  - Yes – Gonzalez, Varela, Puccio, Lebreault, Bermudez, Tejeda
  - The motion passes 6-3.

- Dr. Rodriguez stated that she withdraws her motion to withdraw this item from the agenda and she recommends this item to the Board for approval.

- Mr. Puccio congratulated Mr. Bishop on being named the new Head Football Coach. There are four football coaches who were former players in Perth Amboy. Mr. Bishop is home grown and we need more of that.
- Mrs. Garcia said the Board should do better with these specific items in the future: put the applications out there sooner so we're not waiting until the last minute.
- Mrs. Gonzalez said Mr. Cardona had knee surgery and that's why he's not here otherwise he would have addressed these issues.
- Mr. Bishop thanked everyone and stated that he will do his best and he wants all of the athletes to be scholar athletes. He's going to have mandatory study hall throughout the year. He thanked the Board for this opportunity.

15. **Old Business**

- Mrs. Garcia stated that at the last meeting she and Mr. Ortiz were reprimanded. After doing some research, she found that the President of the Board overstepped her power. She doesn't have the right to punish anyone, only the Commissioner of Education can. The bylaws state that an individual cannot do it themselves. Individuals can express their opinion, but cannot represent their own personal opinion as the opinion of the Board. Government records are subject to OPRA, but not confidential matters. This was violated by certain people when Dr. Caffrey was here, but nothing was done. In accordance with C4102, in Keansburg a Board member was found that they did not violate the code of ethics when they made derogatory comments regarding the Mayor and Council. Whatever comments were made, it's not in your or the Boards power to reprimand them, only the commissioner. If you have problems with Mr. Ortiz or Mrs. Garcia file ethics charges and the commissioner will take care of them. There are still ethics charges against Board members and nothing has happened. She wants the reprimand from the Board taken back because it's illegal.
- Mrs. Garcia made a motion to rescind the Board reprimand. Seconded by Mr. Ortiz. Roll Call Vote:
  - Yes – Garcia, Ortiz
  - No – Gonzalez, Varela, Lebreault, Tejeda, Puccio, Bermudez
  - Abstaining – Roman. The motion does not pass 2-6-1.
- Mr. Lebreault asked with regards to the reprimand, if the Board can give a reprimand.
- Mr. Stern said that it was his understanding that action was taken upon the discussion and advice of Board counsel. It's presumptive of correctness with what the Board does and it can be contested.
- Mrs. Garcia said the bylaws referenced in this matter made no mention of a reprimand.
- Mr. Ortiz agrees with Mrs. Garcia that the code/bylaws quoted don't exist, so how can this be done. If we want this stricken for the record how can we go about doing that? Mr. Stern said he is not aware of the ability to remove anything from a public record. Public records can be amended or appealed, but the record is the record.
- Mrs. Garcia said she will file against the Board with the commissioner.
- Mrs. Roman asked about the proposals to hire a search firm for the Superintendent search.
- Mr. Lebreault said that in speaking with Mr. Jess, the RFP is almost ready. Mr. Jess prepared the RFP and it will be advertised soon. Once the proposals are received, they will be presented to the Board for review.
- Mr. Varela stated that the focus needs to be back on what the Board is here for: a new high school. We should be talking about that. We have been aggressive with one piece of property, but if we don't get this; the hard work for a new high school we go for naught. The existing high school is not adequate for us. He's worried that the city is going to develop the property that we need. We can take the property if we want to, but we need to re-focus on this issue. The city wants to develop this property with retail and more homes.
- Mrs. Roman said there is not a single Board member that would say we don't need a new high school. We have to go to the State and prove ourselves as a district. They laugh at us and don't take us seriously. We need to establish goals and policy to move the district forward.
- Mrs. Garcia said we don't have the ability to choose the land and the State has been here looking at different pieces of land. We have land and it's contaminated and it cost lots of money for cleanup. The Delaney Homes property is still available.



15. Old Business (continued)

- You will have to go through the Federal Government, but we have to prove ourselves to the State. Lots of action has been taken by this Board that upset the Commissioner and we need to stop and work for the kids.
- Mr. Lebreault said he doesn't often disagree with Mrs. Roman, but Perth Amboy may have to be the only district that has to prove ourselves to the State. The new high school will allow us to get better. We have more kids coming in, so we need to do something. We have to do our due diligence and meet to discuss this with the Finance Committee. There's one property that we are interested in, but it's contaminated.
- Mr. Jess stated that the Board hired an environmental consultant to work with them on all soil and potential property issues within the city. Currently we have the Seaman Avenue School property and Mr. Jess has been the only person that has had ongoing discussions with the State about building this school for us. Over the past two years Mr. Jess has had many discussions with the state about the schools that are needed in Perth Amboy. While slow, the discussions have been productive and the state has a trust in Mr. Jess. We are very close to having the State provide a new Seaman Avenue School for us, however the district would have to clean up the land. For a new high school, the district could use eminent domain to take land, but before the district should consider using eminent domain, the district will have to determine if the property is adequate, how contaminated it is and if it's worthwhile and cost effective to clean it up. Mr. Jess will continue working with the State to do what is best for our children.
- Ms. Tejada said if the Seaman Avenue land is contaminated we should clean it up.
- Mr. Puccio asked if a portion of the Seaman Avenue property is un-cleanable.
- Mr. Jess said that he is not aware of that.
- Mr. Puccio said he would like to build a new high school, but he's uncomfortable with building on contaminated property because we don't know what will happen 30 to 40 years from now. In all the years that he's been on the Board he's embarrassed by what went on tonight. We've been told what the rules are at Board member training. Mr. Puccio apologized to Ms. Sheard and Dr. Rodriguez about what went on this evening. We've got to stop this and have no more grandstanding. Everyone here has gone to Board training, everyone knows the rules whether you agree with them or not.
- Mrs. Garcia stated that the Housing Authority is going to construct 71 units on the Delaney Homes site and the redevelopment agency is not going to let them build residential units on that property so whatever land is left can be used for a new high school. Mrs. Garcia said that no one should be ashamed to represent our kids and to get the best possible person for our kids and staff. Our job is to ask questions, not just to say yes. If asking questions is wrong, she's happy to be wrong and will keep at it.
- Mr. Ortiz said that we are ruled by policy and bylaws and we should not be embarrassed by it. He is asking questions that are relevant.

16. New Business

- Mrs. Roman stated that on July 17<sup>th</sup> Dr. Rodriguez informed the Curriculum Committee that the district lost the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Grant. For our community this is drastic news. It affects over 1,000 students in our district in the after school programs. This is what we should be fighting for.
- Dr. Rodriguez said we had this grant for over 10 years. It was a five year grant and we had it for two, five-year sessions. The district does have to reapply each year. The application was sent to the State in April. We tried to ascertain what happened and we are double checking with the State. In the past there were less districts applying for this grant than they are now, but we heard they are only giving it to 12 districts. We were also told that the State was reaching out to other districts who didn't get this grant before. We asked who was given the grant and where we scored, but we haven't heard back yet. We asked the program coordinators to put a small budget together to see what portions of this program we could fund and where those funds would come from. The Federal Government can still change their minds. Three years ago the administration changed the grant and this could be the fallout from those decisions.
- Mrs. Garcia asked if we almost lost this grant last year. Dr. Rodriguez said yes. Mrs. Garcia stated that we need to find out what was done so we can get it back.
- Mr. Varela asked Mr. Jess about the dental program with the JRF. This is supposed to be for our kids and they are supposed to be getting free services, but if they have insurance, their insurance is being used. It looks like we are giving all our students to one provider and no one else to help our kids.
- Mr. Jess stated he will look into this and let everyone know.
- Mr. Lebreault said that when this was approved, it was stated that if the kids had insurance they would not be part of this. We hope that the JRF is living up to their part of the deal.
- Mrs. Garcia said that with new insurance laws everyone has insurance, so how is this happening.

- Mr. Ortiz stated that he's been to many New Jersey School Boards Association classes and he's getting an education on how to run the district. He has brought up and discussed with other Board members from other districts about their interview process and he's asked them if they've participated in the process. He's been told that no other district is doing it.
- A motion was made by Mr. Ortiz to exclude personnel committee members from taking part in the interview process. Seconded by Mrs. Garcia.

- Mr. Stern stated that everything that has been done has been discussed with Board counsel.
- Mrs. Garcia asked if anyone has attended the New Jersey School Board Association meetings? If so, she asked our representative to report on it.

17. Open to the Public

- Public member #1 – asked why was the agenda not on the website in a timely fashion. When the job description for the Director of Personnel & Evaluation was posted it was in a draft form. Why did the public never get a clean copy? This gives a sense of impropriety. It was never brought back in non-draft form. If the Board went with the job description, the public doesn't know which one was used. Dr. Rodriguez said that the draft was by mistake.
- Fall Coaches – the member of the public thanked the Board for approving them because it helps our kids. She participated in the panel and they did interview someone from outside the district, so the process did work. Lastly, parents are responsible for getting their kids to school and we could end up in court if we don't. She came to the high school to get her sons diploma and she couldn't get it. Why? The high school administration said it is Board Policy however this needs to be revisited because it doesn't make any sense.
- Mrs. Garcia and Mr. Bermudez left at 9:28PM during the public portion of the meeting.
- Public member #2 – welcomed Mr. Stern back to the district and stated that we're glad that you're back. She stated that she takes full responsibility for what she says. Since April she has been a volunteer at the YMCA on Saturday from 9:00 am – 3:00 pm. During July she's been working Monday's, Wednesday's and Friday's from 4:00 pm – 6:00 pm in the summer camp. She works with over 75 students and there are a variety of students with different learning levels. We have intelligent students in the district, so how can someone who is 15 years old with no teaching certificate teach a child more than a teacher who works with them for more than 180 days? You need to stop the politics and think of the programs that you're implementing.
- Public member #3 – stated that one Board member said that he would write a letter to the State about a grant being reinstated, but I would write a letter to everyone to look at the administration and the quality of leadership. To bring someone who is on suspension back and make them Interim Superintendent is ridiculous. The Board has so much nepotism, cronyism, discrimination. You get rid of a highly qualified African American because she didn't play ball. He answered the phone when the Board President called to get Ms. Marshall to play ball and attend a meeting at the attorney's office. It was a vendetta. The new person doesn't have human resource experience and the job is 90% human resources.

17. Open to the Public (continued)

- Public member #3 (continued) - This is a thinly veiled attempt to hire an African American to show that you're not discriminating since it comes after a lawsuit has been filed. The new person will not be able to do the job. Dr. Rodriguez is a puppet, as she can't remember anything regarding the number of interviews or job postings. Candidates should not be able to apply after the date. Not everyone on the Board is bad, some are. However Dr. Rodriguez makes stupid decisions and the Board is filled with intellectual midgets.
- Public member #4 – spoke about scholarships and asked if surplus could be used to provide students with scholarships. He stated that he uses Robert's Rules as a guideline on a committee he is on, but they are not governed by them. He is the parliamentarian for a local group. It helps us to function better. Whatever Mr. Ortiz said, he was wrong. Don't let him steamroll you with Robert's Rules. That doesn't govern the Board. People act to make it appear that the Board is dysfunctional. Some people need counseling and Mrs. Gonzalez needs to be more aggressive.
- Public member #5 – spoke on behalf of her students. We're supposed for be role models for our students. They watch channel 34 and tell me what happens. She commends Mrs. Roman who always acts in a respectful manner. We teach respect and if the students say the word 'stupid' they consider it a bad word. We need to be aware of this and remember, as a representative of the students, stop the nonsense and if you want kids to act a certain way you need to do the same.
- Public member #6 – stated that they understood what Mr. Varela said about a new high school, but we remind the Board members about what Governor Christie said. We have to have the courage to move forward. Mrs. Garcia brought up voting on people who support work for you during election time. For most of the Board members the public member can guarantee that they know the rules for this, just because you know someone is looking for a job doesn't mean you ask them to work for you. Unless the person is on the rolls when you file your election forms you're not wrong. Can you use eminent domain for Delaney Homes because 70% of the people who were affected by Hurricane Sandy are going to be put there which give us 30% of the property to take.
